The Houston Heights Woman's Club was founded in 1900 as The Houston Heights Literary Club.

When the founding members of the HHWC adopted a Constitution and By-Laws during the winter of 1905, they included to "aid and encourage charitable and educational interests of Houston Heights" as an important part of the Club's purpose.

In 1912, the Clubhouse at 1846 Harvard Street became the official home of the HHWC. Through volunteerism, community service, and social activities, generations of members have worked to honor the Club's legacy.

Our Club Today

Members gather regularly for educational meetings and potluck luncheons the first Wednesday of each month from October through May. In addition, members participate in activities throughout the year including community service projects, fundraisers, outings and social events.
